

# WSWPLA Notice to Competitors

Dungeness Golf Course, Sept. 12-13, 2018

**Competition:** Eclectic (net)   **Tees:** Silver   **Rules:** summer   **Rating/Slope:** 69.9/118   **Par:** 72  
**Yardage:** 5338

## Specific Course Information:

- **Course layout:** This course is slightly hilly. Very walkable.
- **Bathrooms:** Located on holes #4, #8, #12, #14 (porta-potti behind green), #16, well as the clubhouse
- **Out of Bounds:** Defined by white stakes. If a ball is hit near a white staked area and you are uncertain whether it is out-of-bounds, proceed as if it is a lost ball by hitting a **provisional ball** as described below under **Doubt as to Procedure (Rule 3-3)**.
- **Water & Lateral Hazards:** Lateral water hazards defined by red stakes. Water hazards defined by yellow stakes.
- **Cart paths:** Free drop from cart paths (paved or travelled), flower bed and staked or flagged trees, per USGA rules.
- **Bunkers:** Stones in bunkers are treated as moveable obstructions under Rule 24-1 and can be removed from the bunker.
- **Deer tracks:** All deer tracks may be fixed on the putting surface prior to your stroke.
- **Hole #9 back tee:** This area is surrounded with wood. There is a slim chance it could come into play on Hole # 10. If your stance or ball is impacted by this you take a free drop at the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.

## General Information:

- **Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.**
- **Obstructions:** Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Worn areas adjacent to cart paths or dirt extensions of car paths, and cement curbs bordering or adjacent to cart paths, are considered a part of the cart path and relief without penalty is afforded. Take relief and one club length. (Rule 24) Bare, rocky areas at the bases of trees are *not* Ground Under Repair, and no free relief is available.
- **Doubt as to Procedure (Rule 3-3):** When during play of a hole a competitor is doubtful of her rights or procedure, the player may, **BEFORE TAKING FURTHER ACTION** inform her fellow competitors of her intention to play a second ball under 3-3 and which ball she intends to count if played by the rules. This action **MUST BE REPORTED TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO SIGNING THE SCORE CARD. Please turn in score cards prior to going to the parking lot.** Also, you may call the Pro Shop and ask for a ruling (360-683-6344). Head PGA pro is Garret Smithson. If you get help from the pro, please advise rules chair prior to signing card.
- **PACE OF PLAY:** Please keep up with the group in front of you. **If you think your ball may be lost or out of bounds please hit a provisional ball.** Once you go forward (no more than 50 yds.) you may not return to hit a provisional ball. You may return to where you last hit your ball to put another ball in play but it is not a provisional - it is the ball in play and you must take stroke and distance penalty (one stroke penalty).
- **Reminder:** By signing a competitors score card, you are agreeing with the amount of strokes taken on each hole.
