

WSWPLA Notice to Competitors

Mt. Si, October 6

Competition: Team of 4 (net) **Tees:** Yellow **Rules:** summer **Rating/Slope:** 70.3/113
Par: 72 **Yardage:** 5475

Specific Course Information:

- **Course layout:** This course is very walkable.
- **Bathrooms:** Located past tee box on #4, #8, porta potty to right of #13 tee box, as well as the clubhouse
- **Out of Bounds:** On Holes #1, #2, and #3, and over green on #9 and #18. It is delineated by the Inside edge of poles of fence and white stakes. If a ball is hit near a white staked area and you are uncertain whether it is out-of-bounds, proceed as if it is a lost ball by hitting a **provisional ball** as described below under **Doubt as to Procedure (Rule 3-3)**.
- **Water & Lateral Hazards:** Lateral water hazards defined by redlines. Water hazards defined by yellow lines. Some holes have both yellow and red lines depending on where you go in the hazard. On the outside perimeter of the course, the fences are treated as lateral water hazards, not out-of-bounds. If you are against the elk fences by perimeter, you can take an unplayable lie, if you do not have a swing. If it goes past the fence, it is a one stroke penalty to bring it back in. Your lateral hazard options are the same.
- **Cart paths:** Free drop from cart paths (paved or travelled), staked trees, railroad ties, all barked areas and flower beds. **Bunkers:** Stones in bunkers are treated as moveable obstructions under Rule 24-1 and can be removed from the bunker.
- **Deer tracks:** All deer tracks may be fixed on the putting surface prior to your stroke.

General Information:

- **Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf.**
- **Doubt as to Procedure (Rule 3-3.)** When during play of a hole, a competitor is doubtful of procure, the player may, BEFORE TAKING FURTHER ACTION, inform her fellow competitors of her intention to play a second ball and then say which ball she wishes to play if allowed by the rules. **PLEASE REPORT THIS ACTION TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO SIGNING THE SCORE CARD.** You may call the pro shop for a ruling (425 391-4926) and ask for the pro, Ron Lee. Please advise rules chair prior to signing card. Return cards before going to your car after the round.
- **Obstructions:** Worn areas adjacent to cart paths or dirt extensions of car paths, and cement curbs bordering or adjacent to cart paths, are considered a part of the cart path and relief without penalty is afforded. Take relief and one club length. (Rule 24) Bare, rocky areas at the bases of trees are *not* Ground Under Repair, and no free relief is available.
- **PACE OF PLAY:** Please keep up with the group in front of you. **If you think your ball may be lost or out of bounds please hit a provisional ball.** Once you go forward (no more than 50 yds.) you may not return to hit a provisional ball. You may return to where you last hit your ball to put another ball in play but it is not a provisional - it is the ball in play and you must take stroke and distance penalty (one stroke penalty).
- **Reminder:** By signing a competitor's score card, you are agreeing with the amount of strokes taken on each hole.
